Available in sizes:

Quart and 1 gallon containers.

Wear safety equipment recommended on MSDS, place wet floor signs and read all directions and cautions prior to beginning work.



FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DEODORIZING:

Hold sprayer nozzle 6 to 8 inches from the surface to be cleaned. Thoroughly wet the area. Allow the solution to penetrate for about one minute and then wipe away the soil with a clean cloth or sponge. Do not breathe spray mist. The wiping cloth may be predampened with water or with this product.

FOR DISINFECTION:

Before disinfecting, preclean the surface as in Step 1 above. Then, apply enough fresh solution to thoroughly wet the surface. Allow the disinfecting solution to contact surfaces for 10 minutes before wiping or rinsing the treatment from the surfaces.

TO DISINFECT, CLEAN AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS:

(1)Push water out of the bowl by plunging head of bowl mop into the trap. Then squeeze water from the mop head by pressing it against the inside of the bowl. (2)Pour 1-2 oz. of this product over strands of mop and spread evenly over surface to be cleaned. Scrub surface with mop, especially under flush ring. (3)Allow surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes before flushing...Preliminary cleaning is required to disinfect heavily soiled surfaces.

DISINFECTION/VIRUCIDAL/MILDEW CONTROL/FUNGICIDAL DIRECTIONS:

Trigger spray 6-8 inches from surface, rub with brush, sponge or cloth. Do not breathe spray mist. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe clean with a cloth or tissue (wiper). A rinse with potable water is required for surfaces in direct contact with foods.
