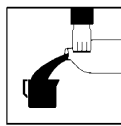

For best results, use Foamanol with warm water. Pour **Foamanol** into sink, and fill at full force to generate billowy suds.



For most dishware and glassware, dilute 190:1 (2/3 oz. per gallon). For pots and pans, dilute 128:1 (1 oz. per gallon).



Place tableware into warm solution; allow to work; clean using pot brush, clean wiper or scouring pad. Rinse thoroughly with clear water, and rack to dry.
