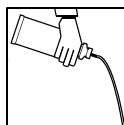

Airade concentrated odor counteractant can be used wherever unwanted odors originate. When deodorizing carpets, draperies, upholstery or other fabrics, pretest an out-of-the-way spot for colorfastness. Do not proceed until you are sure the fabric is colorfast.

To deodorize odors from sickness, incontinence, pet accidents, sewage or garbage, squirt **Airade** directly on source of odor. Effective on hard surfaces such as floors, walls, bedpans, commodes, waste receptacles, hampers and air conditioners.



To deodorize cigarettes and cigars and musty, stale odors, add one squirt of **Airade** per gallon of general purpose and carpet cleaning solutions. To deodorize sinks, drains and portable toilets, add one squirt to sinks and drains, or ½ ounce of **Airade** per gallon of liquid.
